

Privacy Policy

The privacy policy regulates the way Píksel LTD (hereinafter: "the Company") collects and uses the data for visitors and users on the momenti.mk, momenti.com.mk website (hereinafter: "Moments"), as well as the types of information that can be collected and retained in this way.

Information to be collected when you visit the site

- The information you use to identify yourselves when using the services of the Company, that is, the information you provide to us and which you agree to let us process.
- These is information that is not personal, that is, information about the content you are viewing, information about the browser software, which content you click on, which services you visit, the type of computer, and technical information relating to the operating system, and to the internet service provider and the like.
- The service, or the server records that contain technical information about your use of the service, or of the website, such as the IP address, domain, device, or application settings, errors, and hardware activity.

Personal Data Protection

The Company will use personal data in accordance with the Law on Personal Data Protection and other relevant regulations of the Republic of North Macedonia. The Company will not disclose personal information to any third party, except in cases where it is permitted or legally prescribed, in order to exercise its rights or to protect its interests or to comply with judicial orders or other legal or regulatory requirements . Personal data entered on our website are the name, surname and e-mail address of the user. The user guarantees the accuracy of the entered data. The Company does not bear any responsibility if the entered data is incorrect.

Protection of Confidential Information and Data

The Company undertakes all necessary measures to protect confidential information and data in order to prevent loss, theft and misuse, as well as unauthorized access, alteration or destruction. All user information stored in the system is stored in secure databases, protected through various industry standards for access control, secure passwords, SSL encryption, firewalls and other security measures

Registration

The services we provide through Moments can be used only if the user registers in the system. During the registration process, the following information is collected: e-mail, name, surname and password. After registering, you will receive an email as a notification that you have registered in the system and in it you will be provided with details about your account and how to access to it. Later, through your Control Panel, you can add other information about yourself or modify the existing ones.

Cookie Policy

Cookies are small files that are used to collect information that enable recognition of your computer on your next visit to our website, which allows for faster access. Also, in some cases, we record information in the form of cookies on your computer in order to accommodate website visits to your needs and habits. Personal data are not collected through cookies.

All information stored within the cookies can be used only for the needs of the Internet service in a way that will not jeopardize your privacy.

What are cookies?

Cookies are data used by websites to identify web users. Through this data the website can identify the user the next time they visit. Therefore, it is not necessary for the user to identify each time they enter the same web site.

Cookies allow websites to form a user profile based on the data they previously provided, usually for advertising purposes. Advertising agents can use this data to send e-mail for services they find interesting to users.
